

Enhancing Recovery After Surgery

Faculty:

- Invited speaker A/Prof Dileep Lobo is a HPB surgeon & scientist from Nottingham. He is a global authority on perioperative fluid physiology, having published pioneering studies on the impact of fluid overloading on surgical outcomes
- Mr Mattias Soop is a surgeon & senior lecturer at North Shore Hospital, originally from Stockholm, who has been working in enhanced-recovery research in Scandinavia & Europe for over 10 years.
- A/Prof Andrew Hill is a surgeon at Middlemore Hospital who established Australasia's first enhanced-recovery protocol. Within this protocol, he performs on ongoing research programme on novel perioperative interventions.

Perioperative care and surgical technique is developing rapidly. So-called Enhanced-Recovery protocols seek to integrate and optimise surgical care. In elective abdominal surgery, such protocols have been shown to significantly improve postoperative recovery and to reduce the risk of complications.

Topics include:

- Optimal preparation of the surgical patient
- Optimal anaesthesia and fluid therapy
- Optimal surgical techniques
- Optimal nutrition
- Optimal ward care and mobilisation
- Implementation and other practical aspects

The course is limited to 100 participants on a "first come, first serve" basis. We strongly encourage participation by multi-disciplinary teams.
